
Thinking Cap Math installation guide


1. Install Amazon Alexa mobile app on your phone or tablet.

Search for Amazon Alexa app in the iOS App Store or in the Android Google Play Store, and install Amazon Alexa app on your mobile device.



2. Open Amazon Alexa app on your phone/tablet


Allow the app to use your Bluetooth connection when asked to do so, and sign in with your Amazon Account.



3. Tap the **More** button at the bottom of the screen.



4. Choose Skills & Games.




Search for Thinking Cap Math

In the top right corner, tap the search button (a magnifying glass)...


...and type Thinking Cap Math.





6. Enable the skill.

Choose Thinking Cap Math and tap the **ENABLE TO USE** button.




7. Confirm that you are an adult

Thinking Cap Math is currently FREE and you will not be charged for using it! However since Thinking Cap Math is a child-directed skill, Amazon might require you to provide special permission to use this skill and to confirm that you're an adult. To do that, Amazon will ask you to provide identification details such as your credit card three digit CVV number and to confirm via email or via text message. We apologize for this inconvenience, but it is built into Amazon and is required the first time you enable a child-directed skill. After you provide the identification information, Thinking Cap Math skill will be available on your mobile device.

8. Start using Thinking Cap Math

To start using Thinking Cap Math, tap the round blue button at the Home screen of the Alexa app... and say, "start Thinking Cap".
